WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

All players who are in possession of a current federative license, issued by the Royal Spanish Golf Federation, with a national handicap (active and non active) of maximum 36.0, will be able to take part, with the limitations that are subsequently expressed, And who are in possession of either the official certificate of disability of 33% or higher, or absolute incapacity according to the REAL DECREE 1414/2006 of December 1, or the Medical Pass granted by EDGA (European Disabled Golf Association) Either permanently or revisable, the latter being accepted as long as it is valid in 2017, as well as, that European player who is in possession of the Medical Pass issued by the EDGA, provided they provide a issued handicap certificate By its Federation.







Maximum 90 players

CATEGORIES

- Absolute: Players with a handicap equal to or less than 14.4. They will play 36 holes during two
 consecutive days under the modality Medal Play Scratch Indistinct.
- 2nd category: Players with handicap between 14.5 and 24 4. It will be played at 36 holes for two consecutive days under the modality Medal Play Handicap Indistinct.
- 3rd category; Players with a handicap equal to or greater than 24.5. It will be played to 36 holes during two consecutive days under the modality Stableford Indistinct.
- Women: A single category that would play under the modality Stableford, as long as there were
 6 or more players

PAYMENT OF TOURNAMENT. (A help document is attached.)

Entries will be made through the online form created for this purpose on the website of the Golf Federation of Madrid (www.fedgolfmadrid.com) and will be made through a bank card through a secure payment platform. Once the registration has been made, it will be possible to require the accreditation of the handicap to be able to check the relevant data. The closing of registration will be at 12 noon on Monday, September 25, 2017.

For foreign players must send a handicap certificate to marta.martin@fedgolfmadrid.com.

A provisional list of admissions will be published and a period of complaints will be opened, which will end at 12 noon on Tuesday, September 26, 2017. If the number of players exceeds the available places, a cut will be made by a strict order of registration.

PAYMENT FEE.

The registration fee will be € 55.00 which includes the participation of the two days, the training day and the shared buggy or electric car for every day.

OFICIAL HOTEL

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

Maximum 90 players

CATEGORIES

- Absolute: Players with a handicap equal to or less than 14.4. They will play 36 holes during two consecutive days under the modality Medal Play Scratch Indistinct.
- 2nd category: Players with handicap between 14.5 and 24 4. It will be played at 36 holes for two consecutive days under the modality Medal Play Handicap Indistinct.
- 3rd category; Players with a handicap equal to or greater than 24.5. It will be played to 36 holes during two consecutive days under the modality Stableford Indistinct.
- Women: A single category that would play under the modality Stableford, as long as there were 6 or more players

The Tournament Champion will be the absolute winner of the championship while the Madrid Champion of Adapted Golf will be the best federate of Madrid qualified.

The categories would be maintained, as long as there was a minimum participation of 6 players. Otherwise, they would be grouped with the one immediately below.

TEE-MARKERS:

Mens: Yellow Tee-markers. Women: Red Tee-markers.

TEE TIMES:

The Championship Committee will establish the order and schedule







RULES

The tournament is played in accordance with the Rules of Golf approved by the R&A Rules and also with the Modification of The Rules of Golf for Golfers with Disabilities"

ENTRY FORM:

The registration will be closed on the date indicated each year in the corresponding circular for the championship, and must be done on the date and form indicated.

PLAYOFF

In the case of a tie in the position of champion of the absolute category, this will be solved by playing the competitors tied hole to hole, the precise ones to undo the tie. The Championship Committee will establish the order of the holes to play.

BUGGIES:

The Championship Committee will distribute all the buggies that the club facilitates attending to the difficulty of the player when to move by the field according to his disability.

The criteria for the distribution of these will be as follows:

- Medical Pass.
- Mobility scale of the certificate of disability

For all other participants who are not buggy beneficiaries due to non-compliance with the criteria or because they declare that they do not wish to do so, they will be given an electric trolley, by default, or manual as they request for free.

RANGEFINDERS:

The use of distance measuring devices, which exclusively perform this task, is permitted. However, if a distance measuring device has additional functions that allow you to calculate or measure other conditions that could affect a player's game (eg height difference, wind speed, etc.), the use of any of these functions would constitute an infringement of Rule 14.3.
